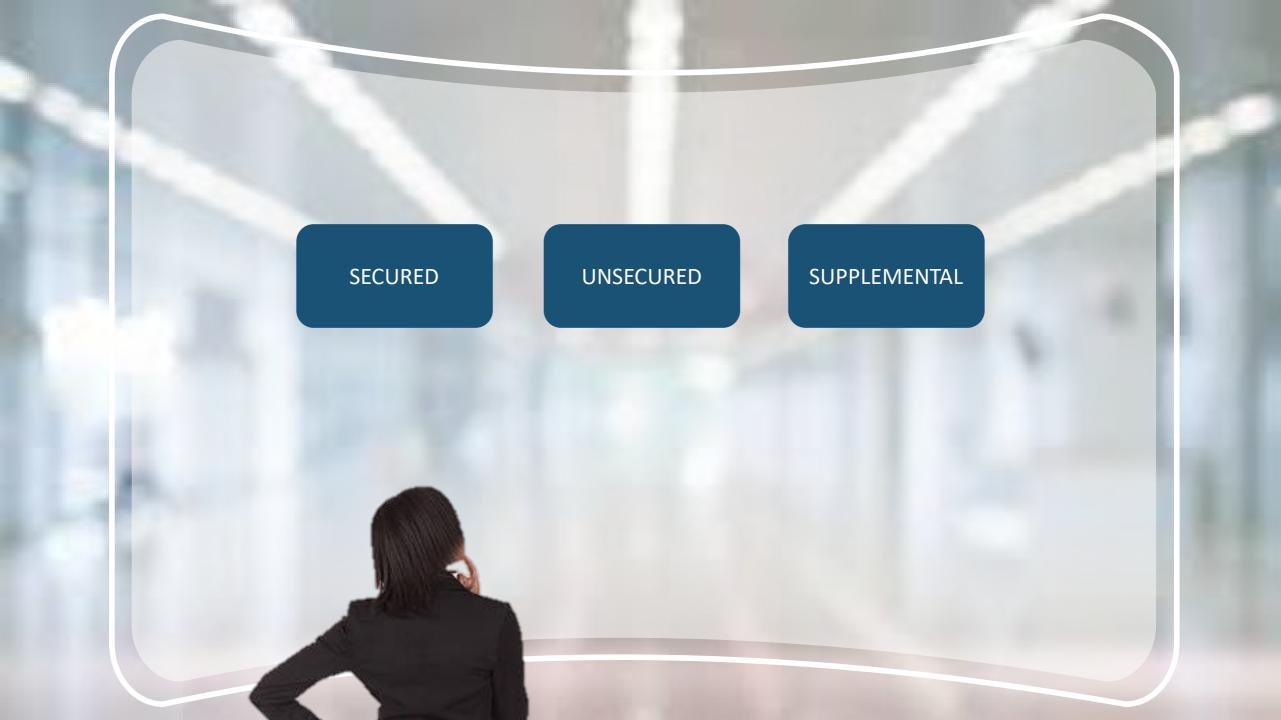

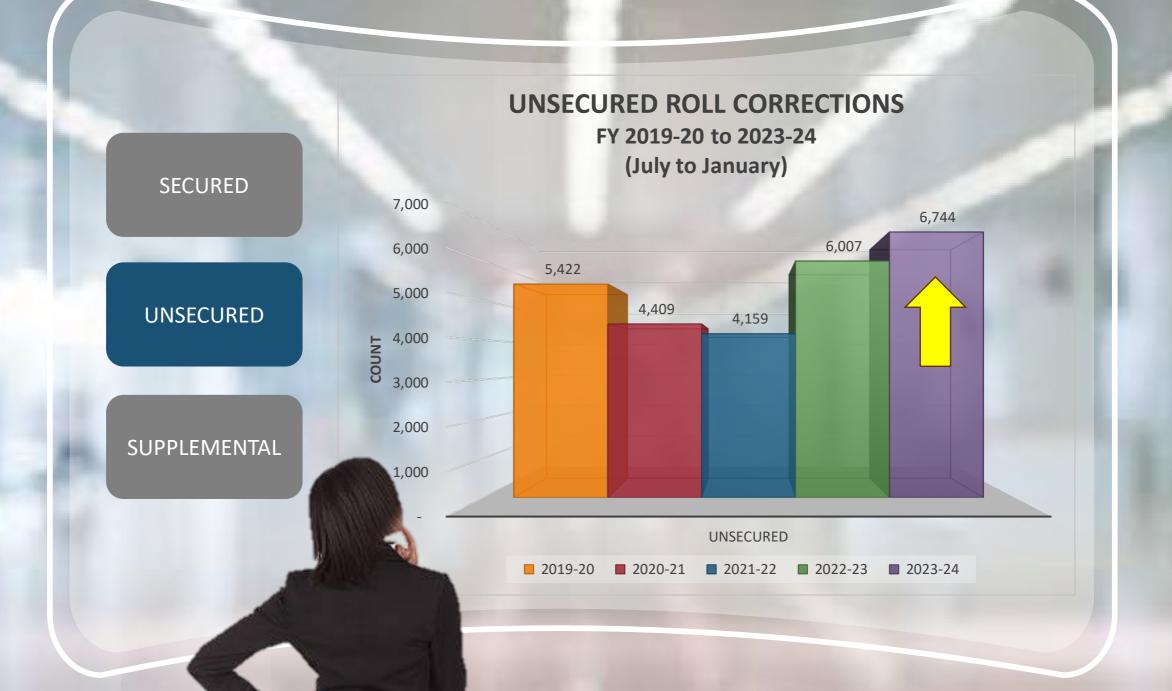

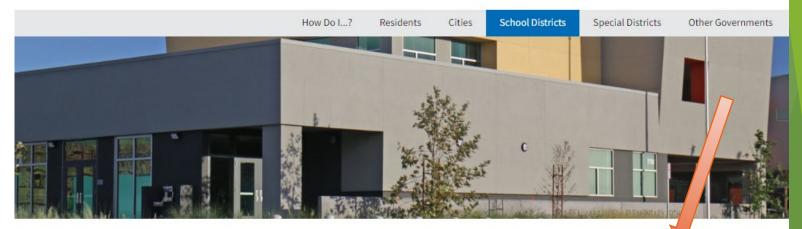

- Approved in the November 3, 2020, General Election
- Added sections 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 to article XIII A of the California Constitution
 - Certain taxpayers may transfer the taxable value of their primary residence to a replacement primary residence, regardless of the replacement residence's value or location.

Local Impact

 Prop 19 Changes in Assessed Value – results in a tax revenue Gain/(Loss) to local agencies

Proposition 19 *Reporting*

- Reporting required by Article XIII, Section 2.3 (a)
- County determines the annual gain/(loss) and reports to the State
 - Assessor's Office determines the Assessed Value Gain/(Loss)
 - Controller-Treasurer Department calculates the revenue impact for each agency and reports to the State

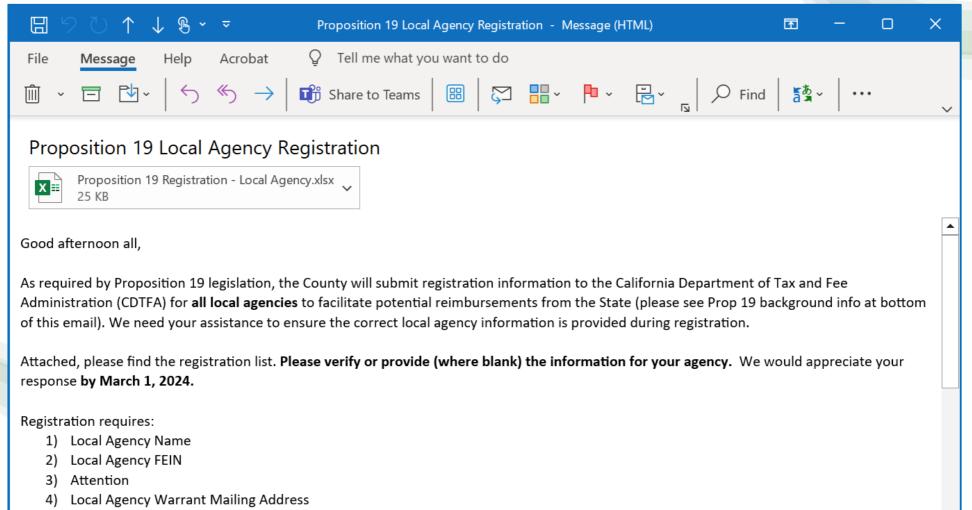

• Determination Period (Annual)

- Initial determination: February 16, 2021, thru June 30, 2022
- Beginning FY2022-23: every fiscal year

Reporting to CDTFA

- Every three years
- January 31, 2025 the first due date for the first three determination periods.
